The arrangement of the sections is at your discretion.

General Rules

- Format: Vertical
- Size: 91cm * 61cm OR 36in*24in
- The use of bullet points, numbers, and headings makes it easy to read.
- Clear and consistent layout.

Necessary Information

- **Summary of the problem and objective** - Context of the research project, problem and objective.
- **Methodology** – Techniques, equipment, and methods used to complete the project.

Add photos/graphs.

- **Results and analysis** - Add Graphs, Photos & Data – present and explain the results concisely.

Don't forget axis titles, captions, and credits for all photos and graphs.

Limit tables with excessive details.

- **Conclusions & Future** - What should the reader remember?

Review of the problem + solution based on the results

What are the next steps?

- **Bibliography** - References including Author, Title, Source, Page...
- **Acknowledgments & Contact** – Partners logos, Contact: Email – QR code

Sans-Serifs (recommended): Arial, Century Gothic & Calibri.

Serifs : Times New Roman, Garamond & Bodoni MT.

Characters size

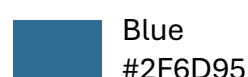
